
Extending the tripod legs




Extend the legs from the upper section, and fold the legs from the lower section.

It is steady to grip the upper part of pipe just above the lock nut when the leg is extended or




Do not remove the nut and take out pieces. If it has been removed, insert the pieces as per the above specification.




Match the space between the stoppers and jutting inside the upper pipe when the pipe is

Operating the center column



Center column stopper is used to lock or unlock center column.


Center column locking nut is used to adjust a tension of the movement. The both of A and B must be locked for fixing center column.




To avoid unnecessary camera vibrations, keep the center column height

Also use the larger legs first when extending the legs.

How to get low position shots



You can get lower height.



- 1.Remove the center column base stopper.
- 2. Remove the lower part of center column.
- 3. Put the center column base stopper on the upper part of center column end.

How to change the leg tips



The leg tips can be converted to the spike leg tips. (sold separately) To remove the rubber leg tip, hold the leg pipe tightly and loosen the rubber leg tip.

Screw the spike leg tip into the leg pipe by finger tips until it comes stop. Then the spike leg tip must be tightened up with the wrench (comes with SPIKE SET).

() Prohibition

If you hold the leg pipe other than the lowest part, the leg pipe may be damaged. Always use the attached wrench for the conversion. The pipe may be damaged.

- DO NOT apply any grease or oil to this product.
- · Clean with a mild detergent and a soft cloth only.
- DO NOT use close to flame. Avoid extreme heat.







Carrying the tripod



*Soft grip is consumables. Replace when it is worn out.


*Color of the soft grip can be stained. Keep out from objects.

Carrying a tripod with a camera left on can result in unexpected accidents. We, therefore, recommend you to remove your camera while carrying the tripod.

Do not attach a camera directly to the attachment screw of the center column. This may damage both your camera and tripod.

In case of the shock given to tripod by force


♠ Caution

When the shock has been given to the tripod and legs such as falling down, check well whether there are cracks, flaws, etc. on the pipes or not.

When you find some cracks, flaws, etc. on the pipes, stop to use it and ask to repair. It may be wounded when some of fibers came out from the pipes. In that case do not touch it.

Clamp head

○ Prohibition



Do not use an optional Clamp head for a carbon fiber tripod.

The pipe may be damaged.


Install the panhandle

Panhandle are installed as shown. There is not difference in length between the panhandle. Panhandle is installed in both side.

Storage


Remove the vertical tilt handle from the panhead, and screw into the back of the pan & tilt handle.

Bubble level



Adjust the bubble level to fit into the center

Attaching the camera to the quick release shoe



Remove the quick release shoe turning the lock lever. In this case, please do not put the lock lever back by force as it has been stood by the stopper.




Align the length of the quick release shoe along the base of the camera body, and securely tighten the mounting wing nut.




When you fix this quick release shoe to pan head, the quick release lock lever will return to the original position automatically.

We, however, recommend you to tighten this lever more to secure the fixing.


Using the pan head



Loosen the pan & tilt handle, and the head will tilt back and forth.




Loosen the panning lock knob, and the head will rotate along the horizontal direction.



Loosen the vertical tilt handle, and the level can be adjusted.


Removing the pan head from the center column



Use the following instructions if you wish to change to another heads, or attach accessories.


First, lock the panning lock knob, then grasp the pan, or vertical tilt handle and turn the head, counter-clockwise to loosen.

Setting the pan head from the center column




Set the new head, or accessory on the tripod's threaded post, and turn clockwise until it comes to a stop. Tighten the panning lock knob and turn clockwise slightly more.

How to change the panhead attachment screw




To change the U3/8" screw, loosen the fixing screw with an allen wrench (2.5mm width) and rotate the center column plate to remove from the center column. Then push out the panhead attachment screw from the bottom.



Flip the panhead attachment screw and put back to the center coumn plate. Screw in the center column plate and the panhead attachment screw. Tighten the fixing screw to avoid the rotating the center column plate while in use.


Three position adjustable legs



To change the angle of each leg, close the leg slightly, and then pull the leg angle adjustment lock out.

There is a choice of two other angle positions.




After choosing the desired leg angle, securely push in the adjustment lock.

Inverting the center column

♠ Caution




Remove the pan head when inverting or replacing the center column.




Remove the center column base stopper turning to the direction of arrow. Loosen the center column stopper and center column locking nut, then pull out the center column.

♠ Caution



Insert the center column from the lower side of the main body, tighten the center column locking nut and the center column stopper. Make sure to re-attach the center column base stopper in order to prevent the center column falling out accidentally.

○ Prohibition



Please do not turn the center column stopper while a center column or optional short center column attached on. The internal parts may be damaged.
