

OProhibition

This product has been designed to handle equipment weighing under 2 kgs (4.41 lbs). Do not overload. Some equipments weighing under 2 kgs (4.41 lbs), such as long lenses, may not balance well due to its weight distribution. In such case, please use a larger tripod.

Carrying the tripod



Carrying a tripod with a camera left on can result in unexpected accidents.

We therefore, recommend you to remove your camera while carrying the tripod.

Setting up !\Caution




To prevent accidental equipment fall or tripod tipping over, making sure all levers, knobs and handles on the tripod are securely tightened. And all of the three legs are opened all the way.

Caution \(\frac{1}{N} \) Caution

A tripod can be tipped over easily depending on the balance of the equipments. Always make sure to be well balanced and hold a camera while adjusting the Horizontal column.

Pan head mounting screw


adaptor to make a big screw.



Do not attach a camera directly to the attachment screw of the Horizontal column.


This may damage both of your camera and the Horizontal column.

Attaching to a tripod




Screw into a head mounting screw on a tripod. The Tripod mounting screw can be converted from U1/4" to U3/8" to remove U1/4" adaptor with a coin etc from the thread


Attaching a head



Screw a head into the Head attachment screw firmly. Also refer to an instruction with the head if possible.


Remove the Angle adaptor





Turn the Angle adaptor knob counter-clockwise to remove the Angle adaptor. U1/4" screw is present on the top of the Horizontal column. A head can be mounted directly on the Horizontal column.

Attaching the Angle adaptor



Angle adaptor. Then turn the Angle adaptor knob



Using the Horizontal column locking knob

⚠ Caution




Turn the Horizontal column locking knob counter-clockwise for adjusting the Horizontal column. Fix the Horizontal column firmly

when the angle is determined. Make sure to hold your camera while adjusting the Horizontal column.

∕∱ Caution


A tripod can be tipped over easily when the Horizontal column stretched to one direction. One of the tripod legs must set the same direction as the direction of the Horizontal column.

OProhibition



Do not disassemble this product. Consult your local dealer if it is disassembled.


♠ Caution



In case the plastic sleeve comes out, follow a procedure below.

- 1. Match the hollow on the Main body and the process on the plastic sleeve.
- 2.To make sure to put the Weight ring when the Horizontal column is inserted.


Using the Angle adjustment knob ♠ Caution



Loosing the Angle adjustment knob allows to adjust vertical and horizontal position.

Make sure to disengage the rosette fully while adjusting the position and to tighten the Angle adjustment knob firmly once the position is determined. Also make sure to hold your camera while adjusting the position.

Using the Weight hook



A tripod can be tipped over easily depending on the balance of the equipments.

Adding weight on the Weight ring may increase a stability of the tripod system.

Care of the tripod

- DO NOT apply any grease or oil to this product.
- Clean with a mild detergent and a soft cloth only.
- DO NOT use close to flame. Avoid extreme heat.
